We are also producing 20,000 leaflets which are pointing visitors to the website to view and download an online copy, our social media and website will also be promoting the digital alternative.”



The 2020 Visitor Guide will be available nationally and locally with new distribution locations and routes helping to deliver the guide to a new audience, as well as still being found in information and visitor centres. In line with the policy to reduce environmental impact there will be no postal copies sent out this year.
