GETTING HERE

Ashburton is easily accessible by road and is located just off the A38 with direct links to Exeter and Plymouth, both only 30 minutes away. On the edge of southern Dartmoor, it's an ideal base for exploring the moors and South Devon coastline.

The town offers a car park with both short-stay and long-stay options, along with convenient on-street parking. And the Ashburton Information Centre is a central hub located near the main car park offering plenty of useful information to help visitors make the most of their visit.
