



Scenic Coastal Beauty

Dawlish is famous for its picturesque coastline, red sandstone cliffs and classic British seaside charm. The Dawlish Water stream running through the town is home to the iconic black swans, making it a unique photo stop for groups.

Dawlish Warren

A nearby Blue Flag beach and nature reserve, ideal for birdwatching, beach games and picnics. There are public toilets, cafes, amusements and plenty of space-perfect for large groups!

Group-Friendly Attractions:

- Dawlish Museum: Local history and exhibitions. Often open to private group tours by prior arrangement. Home to the famous D-Day Bagpipes, which were played by Piper Bill Millin on Sword Beach during the Normandy landings
- Nature Reserve: Ideal for ecotourism and school groups with an interest in wildlife.
- Ditto Trail The Dittos are tiny magical beings who live in Dawlish! There are over 60 Ditto houses to see on the trail.

Easy Access

Dawlish is easily accessible by train (right along the scenic Great Western main line) and coach. The town is also close to Exeter, Teignmouth and Torquay, making it ideal for day trips and base stays. It's strongly advised that you pre-book your visits to discover the best discounts & availability!
