On the doorstep of the Dartmoor National Park and a stone's throw from the Tamar Valley Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty (AONB), Tavistock is a thriving, beautifully friendly market town that is worthy of any visitor. An ancient stannary town and birthplace of the cream tea, Tavistock is the only town in Devon to hold UNESCO world heritage status. A rich history and vibrant high street are waiting for you.

COACH PARKING

The main drop-off point for coaches in Tavistock is outside The Bedford Hotel on Plymouth Road (the A386). Coach parking can be found in Bedford Car Park, opposite the public toilets. for those who would like to walk into town, there is an accessible and flat path along the picturesque River Tavy.



THINGS TO SEE AND DO FOR GROUPS IN TAVISTOCK

Tavistock is the **perfect shopping destination**, with an excellent range of small independent retailers and unique shops. The town is famous for its Pannier Market, offering different themed markets throughout the week.

A mouth-watering variety of **local food stores** can be enjoyed plus an award-winning Farmers' Market which is held on the 2nd & 4th Saturdays of the month on Bedford Square.

Other **themed markets** and events are on offer throughout the year. It truly is a shoppers paradise!

A visit to Tavistock would not be complete without exploring the **town's rich history**, starting at the newly opened Tavistock Guildhall, following on with a guided heritage tour around the town and a gentle walk down the beautiful River Tavy and historic canal.

ITINERARY: A UNESCO TOWN

AM - Visit the Guildhall Gateway Centre and join a guided tour to learn about Tavistock's role in both the World Heritage Site and the wider South West mining landscape, including Dartmoor. Interactive displays explain Tavistock's international architectural and historical significance plus you can visit the former police cells.

LUNCH - The Bedford Hotel.

PM - Explore the town on a guided Heritage Walk or pick up a trail booklet and do it in your own time.

Visit the famous Pannier Market, take in a bit of shopping and finish with a cream tea.

The Bedford Hotel: Central Tavistock, coach parking, 31 rooms, group allocation.

Queens Head Hotel: Central Tavistock, 12 rooms.

The Two Bridges Hotel: On Dartmoor, 15 minutes to Tavistock, coach parking, 32 rooms, group allocation.

The Horn of Plenty: In the Tamar Valley, 8 minutes to Tavistock, coach parking, 16 rooms.
